## **HIGHLIGHTS FROM OUR FIRST QUARTER CENTURY:**

- Granted more than **\$52 million** to local charitable organizations, projects, and initiatives since our very first grant of \$1,000 was made back in 2001.
- Partnered with more than 230 individuals, families, nonprofits, companies, and groups to create charitable funds and help carry out their philanthropic goals while benefitting the Mahoning Valley.
- Casey Krell became the third president of the Community Foundation (March 1, 2024), succeeding Shari Harrell (May 2013-March 2024) and Patty Brozik before
- Stewarded a total of **\$92.3 million** in assets as of 12/31/23.
- Established the Fund for Women and Girls in 2001, our first field of interest fund, built by community support and driven by a Guiding Circle of local residents.
- Orchestrated the **Penguin Parade in 2004** and used the proceeds to help launch and/or build agency funds for local nonprofits.
- Largest gift in history of foundation was **\$9.5 million to establish the Arnett Family** Fund (fund focus is arts and culture, education, underserved populations).
- Launched the Healthy Community Partnership in 2018, focused on collaboration to improve health outcomes.
- Added four supporting organizations William Swanston Charitable Fund, Western Reserve Health Foundation, Trumbull Memorial Health Foundation, and most recently Mahoning Valley Historical Society Foundation in 2023.
